Who are our volunteers?

The types of people who donate their time and energy to the program are from all walks of life, such as:

- 1. Parents,

What can a volunteer expect to do and how much time?

Below is an overview of what a volunteer can expect.

Registration Process for Volunteers (one time only)

- 1. Brief Orientation for new volunteers (10:00AM, Saturday).
- 2. Fill out a volunteer registration form with contact information.
- 3. Fill out a form with your schedule for the Saturdays you can volunteer.

Different ways to be a volunteer

- 1. Tutor Math
- 2. Tutor writing
- 3. Reader (reading buddy)
- 4. Front Desk Manager (registration, sign in/out, name tags, etc)
- 5. Teacher/tutor assistant
- 6. Monitor (keeps track of traffic flow during child pickup and bath room runs)

Daily Activities for Volunteers (note this can vary)

- 1. 10:00AM Arrival
- 2. 10:00AM 10:30AM Setup and assignment (e.g., tutor, monitor, assistant).
- 3. 10:30AM 12:00PM Perform age and skill appropriate assignments
- 4. 12:00PM 12:30PM Breakdown and cleanup
