EXPLANATION: The tuition has been *revised* from \$70,523.92 to \$78,995.44, by the school, due to a miscalculation in the daily rate.

Student ID #98115 and the Teaneck Board of Education, to reimburse the parents in an amount not to exceed \$2,250, for the 2018 Extended School Program; and to reimburse the parents, in an amount not to exceed \$150 per month, toward the insurance deductible for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services.

EXPLANATION: These reimbursement amounts are as per the Settlement Agreement between the Parents and the Teaneck Board of Education. The student required an appropriate ESY program that is not offered by his current placement. The district agreed to reimburse the parents for the cost of the ESY program. Additionally the student receives an ABA program, which the parents have provided, and are receiving reimbursement toward the insurance deductible. Reimbursements shall be made in four installments as follows: July through September of 2018 submitted no earlier than October 1, 2018; October through December of 2018 to be submitted no earlier than April 1, 2019; January through March of 2019 to be submitted no earlier than April 1 of 2019; and April through June of 2019 to be submitted no earlier than July 1, 2019.

11. **RESOLVED:** that the Teaneck Board of Education desires to enter into Joint Purchasing Agreement and will participate as a full member of the Bergen County Region V Council for Special Education for the 2018-2019 school year; does hereby accept, adopt and agree to comply with the Region V Bylaws; designates Dr. Christopher Irving, Superintendent, as its representative to Region V; and empowers (him/her) to cast all votes and take all other actions necessary to represent its interests in Region V.

The Board further approves the joint bidding and transportation agreements for all Teaneck (district) students who are transported through Region V;
