Be It Resolved, that the Teaneck Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves the following Finance and Budget resolutions:

- Whereas**, the Solar Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) Bid was advertised on February 7, 2020. Bids were opened on Wednesday, February 19, 2020. The lowest bid needs to be rejected because a required document (DPMC form 701) was not submitted at the time of the bid and such document was deemed a material deficiency (see letter attached). Secondly, the second lowest bid was above the budget for the project Energy Saving Improvement Plan.

Be It Resolved, per 18A:18A-22.a that the Board rejects the bids because it substantially exceeds the Board of Education's cost estimates for the goods or services.

Dear Mrs. Simmons,

We have reviewed the bid package submitted by the apparent low bidder, EZENERGY Solar Energy Solutions, for the above referenced project. It was the determination of the School District's lawyer Justin A. Marchetta, and our (ESG's) professional opinion that the board reject the bid submittals. EZENERGY Solar Energy Solutions bid submittal paperwork was incomplete due to its failure to include the required DPMC Form 701, a material defect which cannot be waived by the Board. The remaining bid submittals exceed the established project budget. It is our recommendation that Teaneck Public Schools re-advertise the Teaneck Solar PPA bid for re-consideration.

Please confirm this non-compliance of the bid submittal with the board's attorney.
