As we prepare to move to an online model we will be providing Chromebooks to our students in grades 1-4. **The deployment schedule can be found below.** If you do not have access to reliable internet access please notify us when you pick up your device and the district will provide you with a hotspot that will give you free internet access.

For more information about the device you are going to receive, please watch our YouTube video that explains our initiative and mobile device handbook. We encourage you to review the handbook with your child. The device has offsite filtering which allows us to block any explicit or dangerous websites to ensure the safety of our students and devices. The device is the property of Teaneck Public Schools.

Chromebook Deployment Schedule:

All Chromebooks will be deployed at the Teaneck High School - Cranford Street Parking Lot from 10 am to 2 pm. We encourage you to stay in your vehicle and come through the specified lane for Chromebooks.
