- Proposed Capital Project for 2014-2015 -

\$316,345

- Required for access to maintain domestic water piping, sanitary lines, and storm water lines.
- Proposed Capital Projects for 2015-2016 -
 - Bryant Roof Replacement (\$1,144,710 less 40% SDA Grant) = \$686,826
 - ➤ Hawthorne Roof Replacement (\$1,128,860 less 40% SDA Grant) = \$677,316
 - Funding must be secured within 18 months of grant award. Funding to be through Lease Purchase.
