Disposable Masks, Gloves, Hats

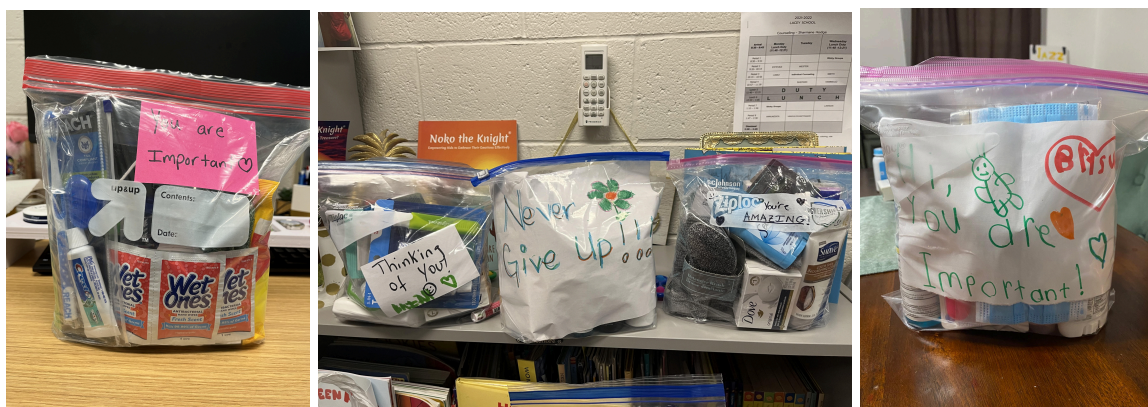
Pocket Tissue/ Wipes/ Hand Sanitizer
