### FIRST AMENDMENT OF POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT

MADE AS OF the 10 day of February, 2021, by and between Teaneck Board of Education, a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey ("Host") and Teaneck Solar LLC, a New Jersey limited liability company ("Provider"), amending the Power Purchase Agreement dated as of the 16<sup>th</sup> of July, 2020 (the "Power Purchase Agreement").

Capitalized terms in this First Amendment have the meaning set forth in the Power Purchase Agreement unless defined otherwise herein.

WHEREAS, Provider is the successor to Teaneck LLC under the Power Purchase Agreement by duly executed and delivered Assignment and Assumption Agreement dated as of the 10<sup>th</sup> of September, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Provider and Host (hereinafter the "Parties") are readying for commencement of construction of the Systems referenced in Exhibit E of the Power Purchase Agreement and are nearing completion of technical due diligence; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined that one of the Systems, to be installed at Benjamin Franklin Middle School (referenced as System No. 2 in Exhibit E), is ineligible for the generation of solar energy due to local conditions on the electrical grid; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have additionally determined that certain of the specifications contained in Exhibit E require adjustments, more accurately to reflect system capacities and other attributes,

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which are acknowledged, the Parties agree to the following amendments of the Power Purchase Agreement:

- 1. That portion of the Project contemplating the installation of a system at Benjamin Franklin Middle School (System 2) is removed from Work to be performed by Provider and shall provide no basis for the determination of any of the rights or obligations of the parties.
- 2. Exhibit B of the Power Purchase Agreement is replaced in its entirety by the Amended Exhibit B attached hereto.
- 3. The specifications set forth in Exhibit E that address the remaining Systems of the Project are adjusted to the extent provided in the attached Amendatory Annex.

All other terms of the Power Purchase Agreement remain in full force and effect.
