Be It Resolved, that the Teaneck Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, approves the following **Finance and Budget** resolutions:

 Whereas, the Teaneck Board of Education, in the County of Bergen, approves the Preliminary 2023-2024 School Year Budget in accordance with N.J.S.A.18A:7F-6 as follows and.

Whereas, a Public Hearing on the Final 2023-2024 School Year Budget will be conducted during the April 26, 2023 Board of Education Meeting.

2. Whereas, the district has a taxing authority which is comprised of:

Allowable Tax Levy Adjustment including Weighted Enrollment Increase	\$ 2,450,440
Allowable Increase in Health Care Costs	\$ 968,522
Base 2022-2023	\$ 96,922,957
Total Available Tax Levy Authority	\$100,341,919

Whereas, the Board has approved that there should be raised, for the General Fund, a tax levy of \$99,830,646, which includes a 3% tax levy increase in the amount of \$2,907,689,

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Teaneck Board of Education, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey approves that the unused, unexpired taxing authority of \$511,274 (Banked Cap) be held for potential use in the subsequent allowable fiscal years.

3. **Whereas**, this budget includes withdrawal from Capital Reserve, in the amount of \$410,000, with a net balance in Capital Reserve in the amount of \$1,797,985, and; **Whereas**, the transfer of these reserves supports the following capital projects that are in addition to the Facilities Efficiency Standards determined by the Commissioner of Education necessary to achieve the Student Learning Standards adopted by the State Board of Education:

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the amount authorized to be withdrawn from the Capital Reserve account is \$410,000.

4. Be It Resolved, that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a), which provides that the Teaneck Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted or such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2023-2024 school year, and

Whereas, the maximum expenditure amount allotted for travel and expense reimbursement for the 2022-2023 was \$117,231; and

Whereas, travel and expense reimbursement has reached a total amount of \$88,180 as of March 1, 2023,

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Teaneck Board of Education, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2023-2024 at the sum of \$70,800, and,

Be It Further Resolved, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum is not exceeded.

5. **Whereas**, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A:5.2(a) mandates boards to establish annually prior to budget preparation, for public relations and each type of professional service, a maximum level of spending for the ensuing school year; and **Whereas**, the budget includes the following appropriations:

6. **Whereas**, the State's estimated Medicaid Eligible Special Education student count (291) is higher than the actual October 2022 Medicaid Eligible Special Education student count (166), and;

Whereas, the State's projected 2023-2024 Special Education Medicaid Initiative (SEMI) Reimbursement Revenue based on its estimated student count is \$111,046,

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Teaneck Board of Education, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey approves Teaneck Special Services requesting County Approval for a SEMI Alternate Revenue Projection of \$63,345 based on the District's actual October 2022 Medicaid Eligible Special Education population for the 2023-2024 budget.
