Teaneck High School administered the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary School Aptitude Test/National Merit School Qualification Test) to 10th and 11th grade students on Wednesday, October 16, 2019.

The PSAT helps students prepare for the SAT while qualifying high scoring juniors for entry into the National Merit Program. The test aligns with the SAT and provides students the opportunity to assess critical reading, mathematical reasoning and writing skills needed for success in college and career.

PSAT/NMSQT scores are available online and paper format. Students should have received an email from College Board with instructions on creating a College Board account, going to their online score report and using their access code to view scores. Paper score reports are also being distributed to students by their school counselor.
