Lowell School Summer Read-a-thon For New First Graders, July-August 2017

Dear Families,

Your children have made great progress in reading this year. Support and maintain this progress over the summer months by joining Lowell School's seventh annual

Summer Read-a-thon. By reading every day, during July and August, students will enjoy escaping in a great story or learning about new topics, while strengthening their reading abilities. When school is out for summer, reading continues to thrive and grow.

Here is how it works:

- Decide on a daily reading goal for your child. To qualify for the Summer Read-athon Certificate, students must read or be read to for a minimum of 30 minutes per day, or 930 minutes per month.
- Students and parents/guardians should read and talk about what they read in order to check for understanding. Leveled book lists and extra Summer Read-athon packets can be found online on the Lowell School eboards, in Ms. Park's and Ms. Giannikos's eboard folders.
- Families will use the <u>July and August Reading Record</u> sheets to keep a record of how many minutes and books they read together each day.
- Parents/Guardians will confirm the time and books the children read by initialing each daily entry.
- At the end of the summer, **add** all the minutes for a grand total.
- Students MUST complete the reflection response about their reading.
 Parents/Guardians may act as scribes.
- The due date to return the entire Read-a-thon packet including: Reading Record sheets, the signed Grand Total sheet, AND the Reading

Reflection sheet is <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 6th</u>. ALL <u>requirements</u> and <u>components</u> must be completed to receive a certificate and memento honoring the summer reading achievement.

Students who complete the requirements of the Read-a-thon will receive recognition at a special September assembly on Friday, September 15th, at 9:00 a.m.
