2018-19 Year in Review

- Received two pre-school grants (nearly \$4 million combined) which enabled us to offer full-day preschool for our general education population and expand the number of "seats" available – from 84 to 195.
- Settled contracts for ALL bargaining units (teachers, administrators, and custodial staff) which are now in place for the next two-three years.
- Announced two significant partnership programs with local colleges/universities one with Bloomfield College for merit scholarships and the other, a summer dual enrollment program for college credits from Fairleigh Dickinson University – at \$250 per course!
- Improved our overall communications and promotion of positive news via a steady flow of emails, phone calls, website updates, and regular posts on our newly launched district Facebook page (which has over 500 followers).
- Established six Superintendent advisory committees that reported back to me on critical work which needs to take place in our district – including a revamp of our Student Code of Conduct and the need to better address diversity and inclusion throughout our schools.
- Collaborated and created a five year District Strategic Plan that will now be the blueprint to guide our district forward.
- Achieved a 95.8% preliminary graduation rate for the Class of 2019 an amazing group of talented students who will clearly go out and make Teaneck very proud!



What is on our horizon 2019-20

- We will be entering into year one of our Strategic Plan which will primarily be focused on planning major educational instructional reforms for our district.
- We will be begin construction on Eugene Field to return the current district office to an early childhood center by September 2020.
- We will have full child study teams in three of schools this year and will be creating an out of district team. The end result will be full teams for all schools by the start of the 2020-21 school year.
- We will be piloting an educational initiative focused on raising instructional practice and rigor in our classrooms. The Institute for Learning (IFL) will be working with a cohort of teachers in our elementary and middle schools. They will also be working with all administrative staff for this year.
- We have added additional math support in the elementary and middle schools.
- We will be constructing a equity and inclusion training program for all district employees.
