WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?



- Transportation is provided to students attending public schools, nonpublic schools, charter schools, out of district vocational and special education schools. The district operates 152 routes, 50 through Region V, 33 through the South Bergen Jointure Commission, 4 routes through jointures with other school districts and 65 routes with contracted providers.
- There are no changes this year to the mileage requirements for Courtesy Busing for grades preschool through four.
- There are no changes to routes or bus stops for non-public school transportation.
- Transportation is provided for athletic teams and field trips.
- Salaries are for a full time transportation secretary, temporary preschool and kindergarten bus aides at the start of the school year and a temporary substitute to assist with the preparation of the District Report of Transported Students.
- Other Expenses include renewal of routing software and office supplies.

STATE GUIDELINES

- Students must be more than 2.0 miles from school for grades preschool to eight
- Students must be more than 2.5 miles from school for grades nine to twelve
- Special education students do not have to meet state mandated mileage if their IEP requires transportation
- Regular, Non-public and Charter school students must meet the state mandated mileage requirements
- Courtesy Busing is provided for students that are 1.4 or more miles from school for grades preschool through four
- A Subscription Busing program for students not eligible for mandated or courtesy busing allows parents to pay the district for transportation, if seats on the bus are available
