Summer EBT Program



The New Jersey Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) Program, launched as part of an initiative to ensure children continue to receive nutritious meals even when school is out, This federally-funded program provides eligible families with an EBT card, similar to a debit card, which is pre-loaded with funds that can be used to purchase healthy food items at authorized stores statewide. Aimed at children who receive free or reduced-price meals during the school year, the Summer EBT program helps to bridge the nutritional gap during the summer break. To ensure eligibility, all families are encouraged to fill out the Online Lunch Application Form.
